May 24-26: Eid Al-Fitr holiday (tentative).

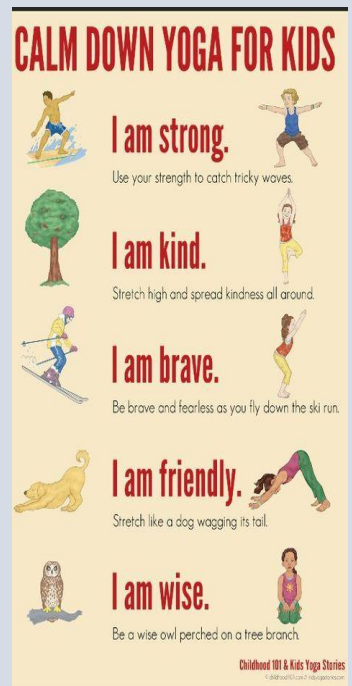
May 27: Summer Holiday begins.
