

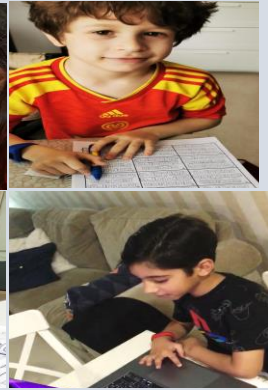

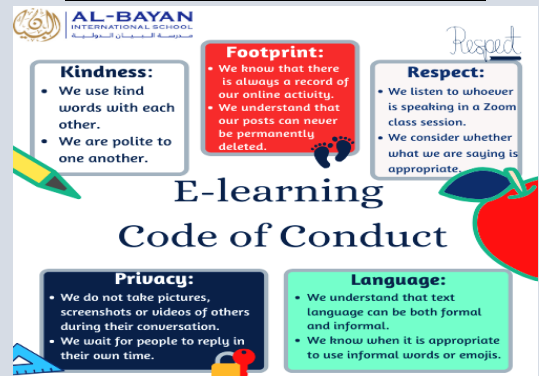


Zoom Video Conferencing Protocol
