### **New Uniform Sales Center**

Our school prides itself on offering the best services to our valued community. The old Uniform Sales Center on the BIS campus will be closed permanently, effective, Saturday, December 28, 2019, at 3:00 PM.

We are pleased to announce that on Saturday, January 4, 2020, we are opening a New Uniform Center at the BBS campus near gate # 6 on Beirut Street, to give parents the opportunity to try the uniform on their children. This new center will also offer the services to pick up the online orders for those who will choose this option or for exchange. The home delivery option will still be available for online orders, which allows the uniform to be delivered within five working days. Additionally, we are launching a new service starting Saturday, January 4, 2020, the Express Delivery, which will allow uniforms to be delivered within 24 – 36 hours.
