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Reminders "Drop off & Pick up" and "Parent Waiting Area"

We would like to remind you that all Grades 1-5 students should be dropped off at Gate 1 each morning for arrival and picked up each afternoon for dismissal. Gate 2 is used for Grades 6-12. Gate 4 is used for KG1-KG2. All students should be dropped off and picked up promptly in the following times: KG 1 and KG 2: 7:20 am – 12:35 pm; Grades 1 – 5: 7:20 am – 2:00 pm; Grades 6-12: 7:20 am – 2:05 pm. Families are welcome to wait for their children in the Parent Waiting Area if they arrived the school before the dismissal times.



Weather Safety at BIS

Time spent outdoors is an important part of the school day. Children should be exposed to fresh air and exercise. However, there are times when it is not safe for students to be outside. To ensure that we provide a safe environment for our children, we have daily AQI checks by the central office using Kuwait City US Embassy Air Quality Station. The necessary action will be communicated by the administration school-wide when applicable. If there is any doubt, the Principals will make the decision as to whether or not students may go outside.
