However, given the announcement from the Ministry of Education that school closure has been extended until August, BIS have made further adjustments to BIS E- Learning program expectations to ensure the successful continuity of learning.

If you decide that your child will continue with e-learning, then we would like to highlight the following information for your child to be **successful**.

Online workload

- The focus of our e-learning will be on the core essential standards for each subject.
- Staff will follow the approach of being flexible and accommodating
- The amount of printed material will decrease significantly with the new "live" sessions being added
- All work given will be intentional and of high quality.
- Students who submit work late will not be penalized as long as it is submitted within a reasonable time-frame
- There will be no quizzes or tests.

- Science, Arabic and Islamic/Qu'ran 2x week
- Social Studies 1x week
- PE / Art / IT 1x week
- Work will be posted on Sundays by 12 noon for parents and students to adequately plan and prepare for the upcoming week.
- Requests for individual academic support should be addressed directly with the relevant teacher.
- Teachers will invite students to small group / IEP sessions on the schedule as per need.

Grading

- For those students who participated from March 2, 2020 and stopped, or for students who have not participated but who wish to continue with e-learning, an opportunity to submit missing work will be offered from now until Tuesday, 14 April 2020, with flexibility for students and families.
- Teachers will identify essential assignments missing for students to submit.
- A list of missing graded assignments per grade/subject will be sent to parents/students.
- Grades for outstanding work to be submitted by 14 April will only reflect in PowerSchool during the week of 19 April, as we expect much work to be submitted.
- Please wait until the week of 19 April before contacting teachers specifically about grades.

Attendance:

- Attending the weekly live lessons is paramount to successful e-learning as new concepts will be introduced.
- Student attendance for live sessions will be recorded weekly.
- The school will follow up with students if there are patterns of irregular attendance or submission of work.

Assignments

- English / Math 2 graded assignments per week
- Science / SS 1 graded assignments per week
- PE / Art / IT 1 graded assignment per week
- Arabic and Islamic 1 graded assignments per week

To ensure quality online teaching, we kindly request your support as parents in the following matters:

- Please reinforce the online etiquette for attending live sessions. Respectful online behavior will ensure quality teaching during these sessions.
- Students who do not follow the online expectations for virtual lessons will be dismissed from the lesson.
- Please ensure that your child joins the online lessons on time.
- Set reminders for when your child's virtual lesson will be.
- For MS students, virtual **lessons will be locked after 10 minutes** to prevent anyone new from joining as to ensure a productive lesson for those who joined on time.

Teachers will communicate directly with students through Google Classroom and/or PowerSchool regarding assignments, deadlines, and expectations. <u>Teachers will</u> <u>continue to hold office hours between 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m., Sunday-Thursday.</u>

We believe it is in the best interest of our students to be engaged in continuing learning even though we are not physically on campus. All teachers are committed to the e-learning program and providing the best support possible.
