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Introduction


Schoology is an online learning management system that empowers teachers with real-time student interaction inside and outside the classroom. Teachers use Schoology to post their classroom materials online, provide a safe forum for students to discuss their ideas and collaborate on projects, and to assign and collect homework electronically. It helps students stay organized and it keeps the class connected.

2. Single Sign-On, or SSO, allows you to log in to Schoology using your BIS Gmail account.




Schoology Home Page

Recent Activity

Recent Activity shows all comments and updates pertaining to your schools, courses, and groups. To filter your feed to view only Updates, Polls, or Blog posts, click the Most Recent link in the top corner and select a filtering option.






Course Dashboard

Upcoming


The **Upcoming** area on the right side of your home page displays events, assignments, tests/quizzes, and discussions with a due date. Hovering over each item displays the course or group associated with the item.

The Grade Report displays a breakdown of your grades for each course. Click a specific course to view each graded item, your grade, the max points, and any comments from the teacher. You may also download a **Student Report** by clicking the button in the top right of the page.




Course updates


The Updates area of the course profile is used by instructors to create announcements and brief messages for the course. Updates will appear in the Updates section of your course as well as on your homepage.






Assignments


1. In the Assignment, click Submit Assignment.
2. Select one of these options:
 - a. Upload: Select a file from your computer.



- b. Create: Create a document on the web using the text editor.



- c. Resources: Select a file from your Resources, which can be a Google Doc.



3. Click Submit to finish.


Assessment

Assessments are a type of graded material used by teachers to evaluate the students' comprehension and readiness. Students can access their Assessments from anywhere they can access other graded materials:

- The main Course page
- The Upcoming feed
- The Calendar
- The Notifications feed

To take an assessment, follow these steps:

1. Click on the name of the assessment.




Discussions

2. Write your comment and click on **Post**.




Schoology Mobile App Login

Once you have an account, download the Schoology app from the App Store/Play Store. Tap the app icon to open it on your device.


1. Use the keyboard to enter the name of the school “**Al-Bayan International School**”.

3. Click on **Log in through your School**.




4. Enter/Select your BIS Gmail account. Then enter your Gmail password.

Mobile App Dashboard

The Schoology app navigation menu allows you to quickly navigate to each essential location on the Schoology App. Tapping the navigation menu in the top left corner of the screen gives you immediate access to:



- **Your profile:** Tap your name to view your personal account profile.
- **Messages:** Messages sent to and from your personal account.
- **Notifications:** Notifications about your **own** Schoology activity.
- **Requests:** Accept or dismiss requests to join courses and groups.
- **Home:** View your course dashboard, recent activity and calendar.
- **Courses:** View courses in which you are directly enrolled.
- **Groups:** View groups in which you are directly enrolled.
- **Resources:** View resources you've uploaded to Schoology and shared resources from groups.
- **Calendar:** View your own calendar in Schoology.
- **Account Settings:** Configure settings for your personal account.
- **Logout:** Log out of the Schoology iOS app.
